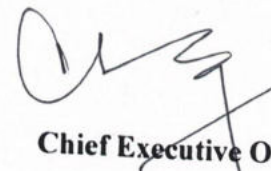

Section-V

1. For the Bidding / Tender Document Purposes, The Oriental Insurance Company Limited (OICL), Country Office, Sunrise Bizz Park, 1st Floor, Charkhal, Dillibazar, P.O. Box: 165, Kathmandu, Nepal shall be referred to as 'OICL' and the Bidder / Successful Bidder shall be referred to as 'Contractor' and / or Bidder or interchangeably.
2. The sealed bidding documents should be delivered in the Country Office of OICL on or before the stipulated date and time. The technical bid and the financial bid must be sealed in separate envelopes super-scribing "Technical Bid" and "Financial Bid" and both these envelopes must be placed in a third envelope super-scribing "Tender for Information System (IS) & VAPT Audit for the F.Y. 2081-82 as per Insurers Information Technology Guidelines 2076". The third envelope should be sealed and addressed to the Chief Executive officer, and delivered at The Oriental Insurance Company Limited (OICL), Country Office, Sunrise Bizz Park, 1st Floor, Charkhal, Dillibazar, and P.O. Box: 165, Kathmandu, Nepal.

4. While all efforts have been taken to avoid errors in the drafting of the tender document, the Bidder is advised to check the same carefully. No claim on account of any errors detected in the tender documents shall be entertained.
5. Each page of the Tender document must be stamped and signed by the person or authorized signatory submitting the Tender in token of his/their having acquainted himself/themselves and accepted the entire tender document including the terms and conditions of the contract. 6. The bidder shall attach the copy of the authorization letter / Power of Attorney as the proof of authorization for signing on behalf of the Bidder.
7. All Bidders are hereby explicitly informed that conditional offers or offers with deviations from the conditions of Contract, the bids not meeting the minimum eligibility criteria, format, or any other requirements, stipulated in the tender documents are liable to be rejected.

10. Bidder shall not be permitted to withdraw his/their offer or modify the terms and conditions thereof. In case the tenderer fails to observe and comply with the stipulations made herein or back out after quoting the rates, the bidder may be blacklisted.
11. **Validity of the Bids:** The quoted bids shall have the validity for a period of 45 days from the date of opening of the tenders.
12. **Opening of Tender:** The tenderer either himself or may authorize any person to be present at the time of opening of the tender. The person attending the opening of the tender on behalf of the tenderer should bring with him a letter of authorization as proof.
13. **Right of Acceptance:** The OICL reserves all rights to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason.
14. **Communication of Acceptance** – Successful bidder shall give acceptance within 10 days from the date of receipt of the work order, failing which, the work order issued stands cancelled.
15. **Disclaimer:** The close relatives of employees of the OICL are prohibited from participation in this tender. The close relatives for this purpose are as defined by NIA.
16. Corrigendum/Amendment to the tender will be affected if required.
17. The tenderer shall bear all cost associated with preparation and submission of tender form.
18. The bidder shall submit the tender form legibly in English and enclose copies wherever required.
19. Bidders sending their bids through courier/by Person should also ensure that their bids reach OICL on the said address within the stipulated date and time. No time extension for courier/by Person shall be granted.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. The purpose of IS & VAPT Audit is that the performance of services is as per "Insurers Information Technology Guidelines 2076" issued by NIA, as applicable to OICL, Kathmandu, Nepal for the 2081-2082.
2. It is the sole responsibility of the deployed IS Audit personnel to execute the assigned work perfectly and accurately as per the Regulator's requirement
3. The OICL shall have the rights to remove any deployed IS & VAPT Audit personnel from the duty who is considered to be undesirable.
4. The contractor shall issue identity card/identity documents of the employees who are deployed to execute the work.
5. The IS & VAPT Auditor shall not subcontract the assigned work to any other agencies.
6. The OICL shall comply with and fulfill the recommendations (if any), if deemed necessary by the OICL, made in writing by the Contractor in connection with the performance of the services.
7. If required amendment to the contract shall be affected from time to time in accordance to Government notifications or otherwise on mutual consent.
8. The contractor shall raise the invoice/Bill after completion of the work.
9. All the payments to the contractor by the OICL shall be made through IPS/Bank transfer only with applicable TDS in accordance with the Govt. of Nepal guidelines from time to time.
10. The contractor shall execute the assigned work as per the schedule and if the same has not been executed up to the expected level, warning notice shall be issued in this regard. If the situation still continues, a penalty shall be imposed at the rate of 1% of the contract value per month.
11. **Jurisdiction of Court:** This contract is governed by the laws of Nepal and shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts in Kathmandu only.
